

# Institutional Framework Map

*Graduated Democracy Superstructure from Creating Ethics*

## I. Structural Overview

The Graduated Democracy Superstructure is a multi-layered governance system where authority flows from ethical grading rather than electoral majorities. Institutions are licensed based on demonstrated moral capacity, and power is distributed through a federation of autonomous nations governed by self-concerned altruism principles.

## II. S.T.A.M.P. Club

### Sovereign Thought Against Manipulated Politics

#### Purpose

Grassroots investigative journalism and citizen intelligence network focused on identifying/countering foreign interference and media manipulation. Operates on structural absurdist philosophy with Amovera principles of freedom and minimized harm.

#### Cell Structure

- **Self-governing territorial units** – compete for party resources based on performance
- **Evolutionary design** – successful structures replicate through cell division
- **Cell charter** – formal declaration of operational structure, signed by founders, oath to S.T.A.M.P. values

## Four Operational Wings (Suit System)

WING	FUNCTION
♠ Spades	Administration and communications operations
♥ Hearts	Charitable wing; moral anthropology research
♦ Diamonds	Creative/entrepreneurial wing; printing press, manufacturing, products
♣ Clubs	Investigative journalism and security wing

## Membership Ranks (Ascending)

- **Seekers** – new members; attend/observe; monthly participation required
- **Laymen** – passed knowledge testing; begin basic training; schedule draftable hours
- **Freemen** – completed bias mitigation certification; choose a suit/wing; advanced training
- **Operators** – fully licensed for autonomous cell operations; can draft labor
- **Graders/Licensors** – operators licensed to evaluate members or train for advanced operations
- **Administrative Board** – peer-reviewed; oversees major decisions via tribunal process

## Key Protocols

- **Ace of Clubs Protocol** – personal investigative study into counterintelligence/foreign interference
- **Symbolic Dossier** – self-analysis of symbolic associations and archetype mapping for recalibration
- **Bias Audit** – exercise identifying political, religious, racial, sexual biases; rate tolerance levels
- **Operational Portfolio** – compiled record of all activities including persona work for review

## Overwatch System

Composed of highest-graded cells; seeds cells with visible whistleblowing channels; direct lines to network of highest-graded cells. Overwatch agents selected via anonymous peer vote on moral integrity. Four-year terms; published journal upon rotation. Operates in secrecy with transparency about membership. Reports to PWC Overwatch Audit.

### III. Personal Warranty Company (PWC)

#### Core Principle

**Self-Concerned Altruism** – company profits linked to customer profits. The more customers earn, the more coverage they need, the more company can charge—but only if company protects earning potential. Creates structural incentive for genuine care.

#### Function

Guarantees financial security over members' lives. Insures résumés (employability/reputation) rather than property. Rehabilitation is qualitative: schooling, therapy, medical help, family assistance.

#### Organizational Structure

OFFICE	FUNCTION
Board of Directors + CEO	Publicly owned company; standard corporate governance
Board of Ethics Oversight Panel	Nested government cell; operates independently; oversees ANC decisions; holds veto power over ANC legislation
Economic Forecasting Office	Risk assessment; geopolitical analysis; future-proofing employment paths
Finance Office	Transaction processing; policy files; anonymized claim ledger
Underwriting Office	Manages fiduciary pool; adjusts coverage against services requested
Investigations Office	Verifies loss of employment; checks for contract breaches
Claims Adjuster Office	Determines available resources; manages program costs
Agencies & Brokerages	Customer contact points; policy education
Auxiliary Services Management	Maintains relationships with colleges, financial planners, healthcare, social workers

#### Coverage Types

- **Job Market Access Assistance** – standard; covers job search costs, advisors, 2-month housing allowance
- **Reeducation Coverage** – standard; covers costs when industry changes render field obsolete
- **Preventative Mental Health** – limited claims per year; therapy, employer leave coverage
- **Family Therapy** – optional; for family situations affecting work performance
- **Career Change Assistance** – optional; transfers coverage for lifestyle-driven career switches
- **Relocation Assistance** – covers moving costs for job-required relocation

#### Grading Metrics

- **Career Median Income Metric** – baseline for profession; triggers action if earning <80%
- **Family Overhead Metric** – evaluates if career earnings cover family planning goals
- **Transferable Skills Discount** – reduces risk/cost based on skill transferability

#### Systemic Role

Acts as moral anchor for the ANP. Financially incentivized to remain static (stability), but service needs require modular adaptability. Holds majority party shares and veto power over boards. PWC Overwatch Audit receives reports from S.T.A.M.P. Overwatch.

## IV. Autonomous Nations Party (ANP)

### Purpose

Political vehicle for implementing graduated democracy. Campaigns for Autonomous Nations Experimental Zone (ANEZ), then expands to full Autonomous Nations of Canada (ANC).

### Organizational Structure

- **Aggregate/bottom-up structure** – composed of local S.T.A.M.P. cells
- **Cells compete for resources** on functional grounds; own administrative structures
- **Cooperate with Board of Ethics** to maintain party-wide basic structure
- **PWC ownership** – guaranteed majority shares; veto power over boards

### Board of Ethics

Apex authority. Large group of moral anthropology cells. Oversees/interprets anthropological research into long-term federation strategy. Affects grading system by which nations receive licensing opportunities.

### Board of Ethics Sub-Components

COMPONENT	FUNCTION
Think Tank (Core)	Processes anthropology cell info into long-term moral strategy; members represent their own cells
Demographics Interests Branch	Identifies public opinion, origins, implementation potential; polling, data analysis, investigative research
Administration Network	Oversees standards, information transfers, cell operations; maintains bias neutrality culture
Outreach & Charity Council	Oversees civic service integration; moral tempering via charitable service requirement for administrators
Moral Anthropology Operations	Tracks cultural drift, foreign influences, philosophical movements; analyzes moral/economic correlations

### Board of Graduation

Extension of Board of Ethics. Oversees graduation cells that manage grading of cells operating in regions. Uses résumé system to manage membership and roles based on demonstrated moral and functional competence.

### Résumé Grading System

- **Education weight** – adjusted by coursework time required
- **Work experience** – added annually via 50% peer review + 50% administrative review
- **Sublime metrics** – wisdom, personal growth, empathy, character, team potential
- **Grade factor** – top résumés correspond to highest percentile; lower ranks align with median income

### Leadership Selection

Board of Ethics members rotate on four-year terms; selected via peer review then party vote. Leader selected by popular vote within party. Board can call for reorganization if leadership ineffective.

## Strategic Operations

- **Joint Investment Strategy Initiative** – works before/after election to profit from proposed changes
- **Activist Investing** – organize financiers to buy company shares, place ethical reps on boards
- **Industry Interests Council** – aligns industry with development proposals; megaprojects
- **Mediation Court** – mediates industry/land/culture disputes; equal votes + 10% Board of Ethics veto

## V. Federation of Autonomous Nations (ANC)

### Core Concept

Nations formed by people—not by fixed borders but by held land. Collectively contribute industries; build laws and security apparatuses they become licensed for. Allows multiple states within same border governing own citizens with own laws.

### Graduated Democracy Superstructure (Federal Level)

Federal oversight body that grades and licenses autonomous nations. Authority flows from ethical grading, not electoral majorities. Highest-graded nations gain most autonomy and responsibility.

### Federal Components

COMPONENT	FUNCTION
Federal Graduated Democracy (FGD)	Graduation cells investigate nations; evaluate for cultural insulation, foreign influence, moral progress
Graduation & Ascension Bureau	Operates under Board of Ethics; anthropology cells inform grading cells; passes recommendations to Ascension Bureau for formal nation establishment
School of Ethics	Reviews all legislation before passage; ensures minimum standard for federation's long-term strategies; built on empirical moral science
CASN (Coalition of Autonomously Secured Nations)	Subgroup of highest-graded nations; licensed for national-level security; provide border security to adjacent lower-graded nations; NATO-like mutual defense
Resource Transportation Grid	Large corridors crossing continent; managed by adjacent nations; highest-graded nation has dominant say

### Nation Grading Metrics

- **Cultural Cohesiveness** – internal narrative control, identity
- **Cultural Insulation** – heavily weighted; ability to control media environment from external influence; can generate own narratives
- **Economic Viability** – industrial capacity, self-sufficiency
- **Humanitarian Capacities** – care systems, rights protections
- **Ecological Stewardship** – environmental management

## Licensing Privileges (Based on Grade)

- **Trade corridor operations** – access and control over resource grid
- **Military/security force buildup** – higher grade = more autonomy
- **Cultural insulation from federal mandates** – freedom from top-down prescription
- **Protection from land buyout** – higher grade = more protections
- **Legislative authority in federation** – participation in mediating inter-nation issues

## Paths to Nationhood

- **Corporate Coalitions** – corporations with populations, security systems, legal apparatuses form nations
- **City-States** – municipalities/cities file to take territory and security under own control
- **First Nations** – automatic right to nationhood; lower threshold for security licenses (reconciliation metric)
- **Cultural Groups** – can file if they have supporting businesses

## Land Exchange System

Replaces war with coercive but non-militarized land buyout. Nations can bid for neighboring land every five years; cost imposed through federation—either paid in full or land surrendered. New nations have protections offsetting buyout vulnerability. After 50 years, nations earn legacy status and form permanent land treaties.

## Security Infrastructure Control

- **Controlled by highest-graded nation in region**
- **To become self-secured** – must outcompete neighbor grades; earn equitable security licensing
- **To own security apparatus** – lobby + win public vote; if lost, lose license and reapply next electoral year

# VI. Auxiliary Systems

## Court of Amovera

Oversees Transcendental Persona Modification (TPM) practice. Panel of judges with four-year terms, two-term lifetime max, eight-year gap required for third term. At least 25% non-practitioner representation. Can be removed by 2/3 judge vote, Board of Ethics, PWC intervention, or 30% participant petition.

## TPM Structure

- **Spotter Corps** – licensed practitioners who assist TPM; work with each practitioner only once; prerequisites include mental health training, trauma-informed practice, protocol certification, apprenticeship, court exam
- **Practitioners** – undergo seven-day licensing course covering structural absurdism and TPM methodology; complete mythic audit before beginning
- **Process** – seven-day structure with preparation, intensive fasting/archetypal work, stabilization, closure ritual, reentry assessment

## Equitalism Economic Framework

Alternative to capitalism/socialism. Enterprises are autonomous legal entities with no owners. Stewards direct but don't own. Property collectively owned by workers/shareholders. Payment via access to company resource pool based on grade. Minimum compensation = land + housing + family of six resources.

### Key Features

- **No personal accounts** – no hoarding mechanism; purchasing power = grade × company resources
- **Portable grades** – workers keep grade when changing companies
- **Guilds** – genealogically connected companies through entrepreneurial grants; political bodies for government communication; graded by PWC for political privilege
- **Entrepreneurship grants** – offered by stewards to high-promise workers

## VII. Institutional Relationships Summary

### Foundation Layer (Grassroots)

S.T.A.M.P. Cells → generate investigative journalism, cultural insulation, citizen intelligence → feed information upward → members form base of ANP

### Financial Anchor Layer

PWC → grades individuals via résumé system → provides coverage that incentivizes ethical business → holds veto over ANP → receives Overwatch reports → anchors stability

### Political Layer

ANP → aggregate of S.T.A.M.P. cells → governed by Board of Ethics → runs activist investing + lobbying → campaigns for ANEZ → implements graduated democracy

### Governance Layer

Board of Ethics → apex moral authority → informed by moral anthropology → guides grading metrics → oversees legislation via School of Ethics → manages Court of Amovera

### Federal Layer

ANC Federation → grades and licenses nations → manages land exchange → controls resource grid → oversees CASN security coalition → allows multiple legal systems within single border

### Key Oversight Flows:

- S.T.A.M.P. Overwatch → reports to → PWC Overwatch Audit
- PWC Board of Ethics Oversight Panel → veto power over → ANC legislation
- Board of Ethics → oversees → Board of Graduation → grades → Nations
- School of Ethics (universities) → reviews → all legislation before passage
- CASN (highest-graded) → provides security → lower-graded nations
